




## Dynamic Support Register Fact Sheet – London Borough of Bromley


### What is the Dynamic Support Register?

 	<p>The Dynamic Support Register (DSR) is for children and young people who have a Learning Disability and/or are Autistic, with a mental health concern that places them at high risk of going into hospital.</p> <p>It brings together health, education and social care to look at the child or young persons needs to help inform plans so they can stay in their communities.</p>
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### What are the benefits of being on the Dynamic Support Register?

	<p>It can help to identify needs early before they get worse.</p> <p>It can help to bring professionals together to look at the support you might need to stay healthy and well in the community.</p>
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**What information is held on the Dynamic Support Register?**

	<p>We hold information that tells us about you and the support you need, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your name</li> <li>• Where you live</li> <li>• What needs you have</li> <li>• Any plans or support you have to help you</li> <li>• Information on health, education and social care</li> </ul>
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**What do we do with the information on the Dynamic Support Register?**

	<p>We work together to look at your needs and to see what support might help you in the community.</p>
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**Where is the Dynamic Support Register held and who will see it?**

	<p>The Dynamic Support Register is held by South East London ICB – Bromley and is shared with people from health, education, social care, the SELECT keyworker programme and the Positive Support Group.</p> <p>The information is held safely and shared with professionals involved in the child/young persons care or planned care. To help make sure they have the right support.</p>
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## Who can refer to the Dynamic Support Register?

	<p>A list of those who can refer to the Dynamic Support Register are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The individual (any age)</li><li>• Family members/carers</li><li>• GP and social prescribers</li><li>• Health, Education and Social Care teams</li><li>• Youth offending teams</li><li>• Local police/teams and Justice system</li><li>• Schools, SEN teams</li><li>• Safeguarding teams</li><li>• Home care, residential or supported living providers</li><li>• Others involved in the health, care, safety, education and treatment of the young person</li></ul>
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## Does consent have to be given to be placed on the Dynamic Support Register?

	<p>Yes. You or your parent/carer must agree to having your information added to the Dynamic Support Register, by signing a consent form.</p>
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## How long will an individual remain on the Dynamic Support Register?

 <p>Up to <b>18</b> Years Old</p>	<p>As long as you still agree to having your details on the register and you still need support, you can stay on the children and young people's Dynamic Support Register up to the age of 18.</p>
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## What if I change my mind about being placed on the Dynamic Support Register?
