## **About this pack:**

- A LAS clinician is on hand for Met Control Room colleagues to support collaboration.
- Regular GRIP calls are in place to capture trends and discuss emerging themes.
- Teams from organisations across London continue to meet and discuss impact and next steps on a weekly basis

#### Initial feedback:

- Partners from all organisations continue to work collaboratively with a real willingness to review and learn
- Patient-welfare is put at the heart of any decision made, consistently across all organisations
- No significant incidents have been reported

#### **Ongoing focus**

- Ongoing updates and broadcasts are being developed.
- Data and benchmarking continues to be developed to ensure impact can be monitored
- Workforce modelling is underway to understand ongoing resource requirements across the system
